FROM YOUR SELECT BOARD

The Selectboard is working to develop a community-driven process to direct future town infrastructure development, including the needs surrounding the Town Office Building. We have reached out to a few groups for support, and on Monday June 19th, a representative from the Vermont Council on Rural Development (VCRD) will be coming to our Selectboard meeting to present on the work of the VCRD and how they may help us develop a structure to move our process forward. While regular Selectboard meetings are always open, we invite the community to attend this meeting to learn about this community-driven process and how the VCRD may be able to help us. Please note we will not be discussing details about the town office building, but rather the structure and process in which we will be working on the town office building project. Exact time and location for the meeting will be announced in the agenda once it is posted.

We will also be starting some needed repairs to our building on Main Street, beginning with the roof. Though the future use of the building is as yet undecided, maintaining it continues to be a responsibility of the Town. The building remains an asset of the Town, and as landlords we are responsible for ensuring that the Post Office can conduct business in a functional environment, and that no further deterioration occurs to the structure as a result of deferred maintenance.
