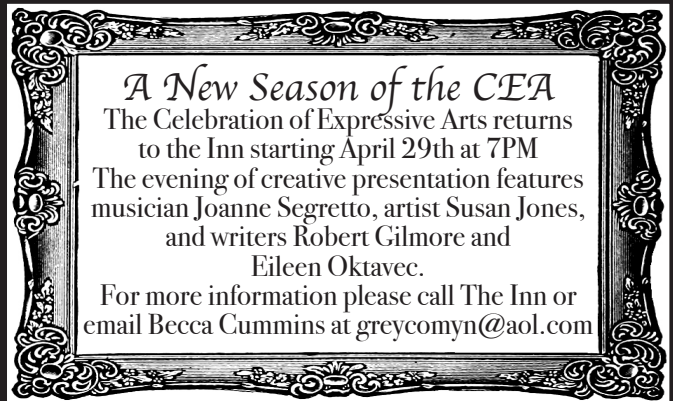


WINTER FARMERS MARKET

The Montgomery Board of Listers will soon be conducting visits to properties that have been changed in the last year. Affected property owners will be notified and an appointment will be made to visit each site to access those changes. Upon completion of those visits a "change of appraisal" notice will be sent to those property owners informing them of any adjustments to their assessment. The letter will include the new assessed value and how to appeal if that is your interest. Information on the process will be posted in both Post Offices, the Town Office, and the on the Town website: www.montgomeryvt.us.
