The Red Barn Studio in Montgomery Village is now open for the season and all art pieces are 40% off.

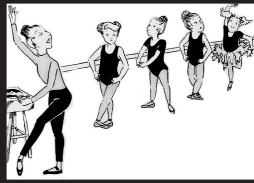
