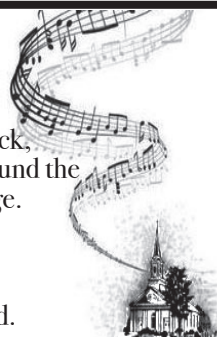

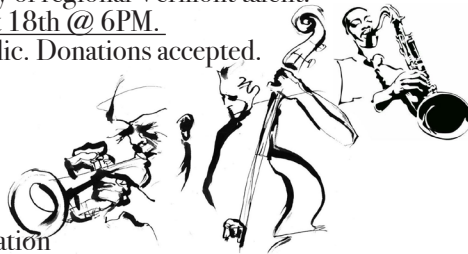
Celebration of Expressive Arts

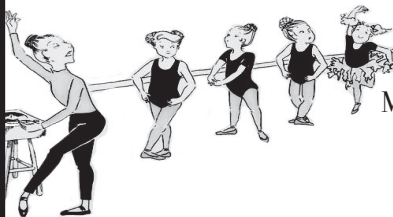
PoJazz @ THE MCA
