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CONSERVATION COMMISSION MEETING (unapproved draft) WEDNESDAY, DECEMBER 7, 2016

The meeting was called to order at 5:02 p.m. at the Public Safety Building (PSB) conference room. In attendance: Charlie Hancock, Sue Wilson, Joan Hildreth. Absent: Misty McCartney, Todd Lantery. Visitor(s): None.

- Additions/Deletions to Agenda None
- <u>Minutes from November 2, 2016</u> reviewed. Charlie made a motion to approve the November minutes as written, Sue seconded, the motion passed. November minutes approved.
- Treasurer's Report/Fundraising Update: Sue reported that, year-to-date (YTD), we have received \$2,305.00 in membership from 38 people. In addition, Sue presented a report outlining the YTD income and expenses, as well as each year's budgeted and actual figures from 2014 to 2016. The 2017 budget was then worked on during the meeting. A level funding request for \$750 will be made to the Town. The 2017 proposed budget outlines \$3,250 in revenue and \$1,750 in expenses.
- <u>Town Report letter</u> Charlie will write a new letter which will accompany the budget in the Town Report.

- <u>Municipal Planning Grant:</u> Charlie reported that the grant was denied, but we can re-apply on the next round. Uncertain when that will be.
- Proposed/Events:
 - XC/Snowshoe/Tracking/Winter Tree ID Outing co-sponsored with RCC, February 11, 2017 (with backup of Feb. 18) Time and other details TBD. Most likely at Richford Elementary School.
