Agenda:

Additions and/or Deletions to the Agenda: Barry noted that we should include an item titled "Public Comment" and moves to do so as an addition to the present agenda. Roberta seconded. Vote: 3-0 Passed

Barry moved to move the approval of March 8 minutes down so that Joe can be present to vote on it. Roberta seconded 3-0 passed.

Approval of March 8, 2016 Minutes

Roberta moved to approve the minutes as written. Joe seconded. 3-0-1, with Abe abstaining. Bylaws

a. Confirm Changes/Clarifications to be sent to Amanda

1. Yes. We did intend that fences not be required to meet setbacks.

2. Structure. Should read "(27) "Structure" means an assembly of materials for occupancy or use, including a building, mobile home or trailer, sign, wall, or fence." as stated in Statutory definitions. We will add FEMA language "For the purposes of Floodplain management under Article 8; "A walled and roofed building, as well as a manufactured home, and any related built systems, including gas or liquid storage tanks." Barry moved that a note should be inserted into the current bylaws stating that the definition of "Structure" on P. 75 is in conflict with statute and it should read as above. Passed 4-0

3. P. 5 6.4(2) also is not identical to statute. Next opportunity to amend should correct. In the meantime, a note should be added to bylaws noting correction and proper language. Should read and shall be interpreted by ZA and DRB as "(5) No defect in the form or substance of any requirements in subdivision (1) or (2) of this subsection shall invalidate the action of the appropriate municipal panel where reasonable efforts are made to provide adequate posting and notice. However, the action shall be invalid when the defective posting or notice was materially misleading in content. If an action is ruled to be invalid by the Environmental Division or by the applicable municipal panel itself, the action shall be remanded to the applicable municipal panel to provide and notice, hold a new hearing, and take a new action." Roberta seconded. Approved 4-0.

Meets and bounds for all districts. Merle requested the bylaws include meets and bounds for all districts. Noted that the 2010 bylaws contained meets and bounds for all but Ag/Res and Con I and Con II. We should include the old descriptions (as modified and shown on maps). Also the meets and bounds of several V2 were changed.

Yard sales. We cannot substantially change at present. At next amendment round the Commission will revisit.

P. 75 "Start of Construction" This is an error. To correct in next minutes. Suggest to selectboard that if a permit expires because of 180 days, rather than 365, the permit fee for a new permit shall be \$1.00.

Report Village Designation Grant

Maps submitted by Amanda need to be checked to determine whether businesses shown are still there.
