EXECUTIVE ORDER UPDATE FROM GOVERNOR PHIL SCOTT:

Addendum 8 Amended & Restated Executive Order 01-20:

NOW THEREFORE, I, Philip B. Scott, by virtue of the authority vested in me as Governor of Vermont by the Constitution of the State of Vermont, the emergency powers set forth in 20 V.S.A. §§ 8, 9 and 11 and other laws, **hereby declare the State of Emergency for the State of Vermont shall be extended through midnight on Tuesday, December 15, 2020.**

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED:

Effective Saturday, November 14, 2020 at 10:00 p.m.:

Section 2, item i: Telework. All businesses, not-for-profit entities and **Municipal Government entities** in the State shall reinstitute, to the maximum extent possible, or re-emphasize to the extent necessary, telecommuting or work from home procedures. **In person meetings are strongly discouraged** and all meetings should be held by telephone or electronically to avoid in person meetings whenever possible. This Addendum 8 to the Amended and Restated Executive Order shall take effect upon signing and shall continue in full force and effect until midnight on December 15, 2020, at which time the Governor, in consultation with the Vermont Department of Health and the Department of Public Safety shall assess the emergency and determine whether to amend or extend the Executive Order.
