Tennis Courts: Someone from Advantage Tennis is coming to give a quote for work that is needed on the courts. A second quote will be done later this month from another company. The work is planned for next spring, when weather allows.

Ice: There was discussion about whether to continue having an ice rink at the rec center. It is very labor intensive and difficult to find volunteers to keep it going. Peg will look into skating time at Jay Peak and whether there could be an arrangement for Montgomery residents.

Clean up: The November meeting will include cleaning the buildings and grounds for the season. Another afternoon date TBD will center on cleaning out the storage shed.

River Walk: The rocks left over from the stairs project were moved, defining a barrier between the parking lot and the field. Also, improvements were made to the stairs leading to the boat launch and beach area. Marsha made a motion to pay Tokyo Blocher \$150 for moving the rocks. Second by Peg. All voted in favor. Brendan made a motion to pay Mickey Doheny up to \$250 to add fill to repair drainage in the parking area and path. Second by Lisa. All voted in favor.

Halloween: There will be a dance with food and live music at the Grange on Saturday, 10/27. Decorations will be left up for the children's party on Halloween evening.
