Tennis Courts: The courts have a couple of large cracks and several smaller cracks. The red areas around the courts also need to be painted. Repairs will most likely take place early next summer. We have asked for an estimate from Advantage Tennis.

Summer Camp: Things went smoothly at camp this summer. There were 76 kids registered for camp and the majority of them were nine years old or younger. There was an average of 40 campers per day.

River Walk: Vermont Youth Core finished the stairs project at Riverwalk. There are several large rocks left over that need to be moved. These will be positioned along the ball field side of the parking area.

Halloween: There will be a dance at the Grange on Saturday, 10/27. Decorations will be left up for the children's party on Halloween.
