The month of **June** resulted in 107 patron visits.

Total of 297 Circulation Transactions took place, 43 DVDs, 137 Adult Books, 23 Children's Books, 22 YA and Juvenile books. 27 E-books and 66 Audiobooks were checked out through OverDrive. There were 2 movies streamed through Kanopy.

Books, DVDS & Subscription Y-D is \$ 6,657.48

Programming Y-D is \$855.76
