## NORTHWEST VERMONT SOLID WASTE MANAGEMENT DISTRICT SPECIAL MEETING MARCH 7, 2023

### ARTICLE I

Shall general obligation bonds of Northwest Vermont Solid Waste Management District in an amount not to exceed One Million, Five Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$1,500,000), subject to reduction by the application of reserve funds and federal and state grants-in-aid, be issued for the purpose of making certain public solid waste improvements, namely expansion of the Georgia Recycling Center and offices including commodity storage, waste collection, and household hazardous waste collection facilities, the aggregate estimated cost of such improvements being One Million, Five Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$1,500,000), such debt service to be paid from NWSWD Operating Revenues? It is anticipated that revenues through District services will be sufficient to cover District obligations for repayment. If however these fees are insufficient to enable the District to make timely payments of any amount due, the District will collect any deficiency through increased rates to District provided services, assessments and surcharges in an equitable manner. As provided in the District Charter, obligations incurred under chapter 53 Title 24, VT Statutes Annotated, shall be the joint obligation of the District and Each Member Municipality.
